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Meter: 4/4

Formation: Open circle in W position

Start with drum (after the few notes of solo clarinet)

Bar 1: Facing diagonally left of center and moving backwards, čukče on L (1) step R to R (2), step L behind R (3), step R to R (4)

Bar 2: Čukče on R as body turns to face diagonally R of center (1) Cross L over R (2), Step R to R (3), Cross L over R (4)

Bar 3: Čukče on L and swing R around, lower arms so they are pointing diagonally down and forward (1) step R across L (2), Step L to L (3), Cross R over L (4)

Bar 4: Čukče on R, Swing L around (1) step L across R (2), Step R to R (3), Cross L over R (4)

Bars 5-8 repeat bars 1-4, bring hands back up to W position to start.

Bar 9: with feet together swivel heels to the R (1,2), swivel heels to the L (3,4)
