Music: Elvira by the Oak Ridge Boys

Formation: solo, facing all the same wall

Choreographer: unknown

Meter: 4/4

There are several different versions of this dance. This is the way we do it in Tucson. In our version, it's a 5 measure dance. There are variations with only 4 measures out there to be found on the web, these appear to be identical to the [Electric Slide](http://folkdancemusings.blogspot.com/2014/06/electric-slide-usa.html) [<http://folkdancemusings.blogspot.com/2014/06/electric-slide-usa.html>] .

Bar 1: Step R to R (1), Step L behind R (2), Step R to R (3), hitch L leg up, clap (4)

Bar 2: Step L to L (1), Step R behind L (2), Step L to L (3), hitch R leg up, clap (4)

Bar 3: Step R, L, R, backing straight back (1,2,3), Hitch L (4)

Bar 4: Rock Forward on L (1,2) and backwards on the L (3,4)

Bar 5: Rock forward on L (1), Back on L (2), rock forward on the L with a 1/4 turn to the L (CCW) (3), Hitch R (4)
