49-64	1st and 2nd cpls polka swing, ballroom hold, once and a half CCW around each other to progressed places.

1-16	1st and 2nd cpls R and L hand star. 3rd and 4th cpls the same.
17-32	1st and 2nd cpls ladies chain. 3rd and 4th cpls the same.
33-48	1st and 4th cpls R and L hand star. 3rd and 2nd cpls the same.
49-64	
1-16	W to the ctr and out to places, M to the ctr turn L and swing the Won the L.
17-32 33-64) 1-64)	Promenade the set M to own places with new ptr. Repeat this figure three times until all are in original places.
