Record: The Border Country Dance Band, FE 007. 6/8 meter.

Formation: Longways set of four cpls.


Steps: Skip Change of Step; Slip Step.

$\underline{\mathtt{Bars}}$	Pattern
1-4	Joining hands on the sides, all dance four small Slip Steps to the R and four small Slip Steps back to place (Figure 1).
5-8	All turn ptr with R hand.
9-12	Joining hands on the sides, all dance four small Slip Steps to the L and four small Slip Steps back to place.
13-16	All turn ptr with L hand.
17-18	1st cpl cast off one place, meet in the middle of the set
	with nearer hands joined, facing up.
19-20	1st cpl dance up to the top.
21-24	1st cpl cast to the bottom of the set (standing cpls join-
	ing hands on the side lines, step up on bars 23-24).

Repeat with a new top cpl.

All circle round and back.
