A 32 bar Strathspey for 4 cpls. Described in Preston, circa 1786.

Record: Tacsound TAC001

4/4 meter

Formation: 4 cpls in longways formation.

Steps: Strathspey Travelling Step; Strathspey Setting Step.

Bars

Pattern

|-------|--|
| 1-4 | 1st cpl turn with R hands and cast off one place.
2nd cpl move up. |
| 5-8 | 1st cpl turn with L hands 1 1/4 times to position
as in Diagram I. |
| 9-12 | Set three and three twice, finishing as in Diagram II. |
| 13-16 | Set three and three twice. |
| 17-24 | 1st, 2nd and 3rd cpls six hands round and back. |
| 25-30 | Reels of three at the sides. 1st cpl begin the reel
by giving R shldr to the person on their R (Diagram III). |
| 31-32 | 1st cpl cross over to own sides, one place down. |

Repeat, having passed a cpl.

Diagram Legend: ○ = M □ = W

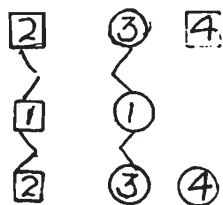

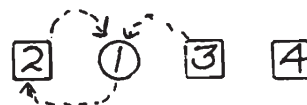
