I. TURN PARTNER, HONOR LEFT AND RIGHT

1-4 Join both hands with ptr and beg R turn once CW, arms held at chest level and rounded.

Advance and retire with the person diag to L. (Move fwd 2 strathspey steps and bkwd 2 strathspey steps.) Dance back-to-back with ptr, moving CW and passing by the R shldr going fwd and L moving 9 - 12

Repeat dance with new ptr (the 5th person).

13 - 16Repeat meas 5-8, except advance and retire with person to R.

II. TURNS AND PROGRESS

bkwd.

Join R hands with ptr and, beg R, turn once CW.

Progress fwd, M LOD on the inside of the circle, W RLOD on the outside. Pass 4 people

5-8 Join L hands with the person diag to L and turn once CW.
