

Electric Slide (USA)

This is an old disco line dance that's made it's way into both hip hop and country line dance traditions. We also do it in folk dancing -- the country line dance way. It's nearly identical to [Elvira \[http://folkdancemusings.blogspot.com/2014/06/elvira-usa.html\]](http://folkdancemusings.blogspot.com/2014/06/elvira-usa.html) but has a different ending. It also has only 18, counts where Elvira has 20.

Formation: solo, facing all the same wall

Choreographer: unknown

Meter: 2/4

Bar 1: Step R to R (1), Step L behind R (2),

Bar 2: Step R to R (1), hitch L leg up, clap (2)

Bar 3: Step L to L (1), Step R behind L (2),

Bar 4: Step L to L (2), hitch R leg up, clap (2)

Bar 5-6: Step R, L, R, backing straight back (1,2,1), Hitch L (2)

Bar 7-8: Rock Forward on L (1,2) and backwards on the L (1,2)

Bar 9: Step L forward on L making a 1/4 turn to the Left (CCW) (1), Hitch R (2)
