INTRODUCTION

PART I

Step fwd to ctr on R, swinging arms slightly fwd.

Step bkwd on L, lowering arms.

Step on R behind L; step on L to L.

Slow step on R across in front of L.

Step on L to L; balance on R to R.

Mayim step with L moving CCW.

Slow step on L across in front of R.

Repeat meas 1-8.

PART II

- Full turn to R (CW) with R, L.

 Slow step fwd on R in LOD.

 Walk fwd L, R in LOD.

 Step fwd on L and rise on ball of ft, raising arms up.

 Step on R behind in place, lowering arms; step on L to L, facing ctr.

 Slow step on R across in front of L, raising on ball of ft, turning slightly to L.

 Step on L behind in place; step on R to R, facing ctr.
- Step on L behind in place; step on R to R, facing ctr.

 Slow step on L in front of R with a straight knee.
- Facing CCW, slow step on R to R (outside).
 Full turn to L (CCW) into ctr with L, R.
- 11 Step on L to L and turn L to face ctr.
- 12 Slow step fwd on R, raising on ball of ft, raising arms up.
- Step bkwd on L; turn R and step on R to R and outside.
- Step on L across in front of R; step on R, moving out.
- 15-16 Turning L to face ctr, Yemenite bkwd with L.

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
