Formation: Circle, face ctr, join hands.

Pattern
INTRODUCTION.
PART ONE. Yemenite R with hop. Yemenite L with hop. R crosses in front of L with a slight stamp. Body is bent down with shldr turned twd ctr. Step-hop bkwd on L, body up. R to R side. Repeat action of cts 9-12 with opp ftwk. Release hands, R fwd and 1/2 turn to L (with back to ctr), with a slight stamp. L fwd(moving out of the circle). Step-Hop R fwd. L fwd. R fwd. Step-hop L fwd. R stamps fwd with a 1/2 turn to L (face ctr of circle). Repeat action of cts 18-24, but moving into the circle.
PART TWO. (Arms on each other's shldrs, facing ctr.)
Balance step R (R,L,R in place). Balance step L (L,R,L in place). Run two steps to R (remain facing ctr). Balance step on R ft. Repeat action of cts 1-8, Part Two, with opp ftwk. Repeat action of cts 1-16, Part Two. Repeat dance three more times.
