Ft together, facing ctr of circle, with arms on neighbors' shldrs: bounce five times. The last bounce is somewhat deeper than the others. Hold Bounce twice. Small leap on R ft to R side. L cross in front of R. R closes to L (wt on both). R to R side. L touches next to R. Repeat action of cts 23-26, with opp ftwk and direction. Arms down. Hold.
