Formation: Semi circle, arms in T-pos.

FIGURE I

- 1 Step on R to R.
- 2 Touch L toe next to R.
- 3 Step on L to L.
- 4 Touch R toe next to L.
- 5-8 Repeat cts 1-4.

FIGURE II

- 1 Bounce on both knees down.
- 2 Two quick bounces on both knees up.
- 3 Bounce on both knees down again.
- 4 One quick bounce on both knees up.
- & Pull L knee fwd on the toe, R is flat.
- 5 Pull R knee fwd on the toe, L flat and bounce on the knee.
- 6 Repeat ct 5.
- 7 Pull R knee back and L knee goes fwd with a bounce.
- 8 Pull L knee back and R knee goes fwd.

FIGURE III

- 1 Jump on both feet in place and bend knees as you land.
- 2 Quick jump on both in place again.
- & Hop on R in place and lift L back.
- 3 Hop on L in place and lift R back.
- 4 Quick jump on both in place.
- & Hop on R in place and lift L back.
- 5 Hop on L in place and kick R fwd.
- 6 Hop again on L in place and a little kick on R in the front.
- 7 Hop on L in place.
- & Leap onto R to R.
- 8 Leap onto L across in front of R.
